The Anglican Communion was formed of necessity and a desire to keep the rich heritage and relationship we share in our unique place in Christianity. Its structures were born in response to various conflicts it faced through the years. Events of recent years have led the communion to try to become more intentional and articulate in its nature and structure. A representative group has spent the last several years forging a draft covenant for the communion to examine, amend, and eventually adopt. The Episcopal Church has asked all congregations to conduct a study of the “final” draft and return responses to their review of this covenant. Starting this **Sunday, March 20**, we will be having this study during the adult forum **at 9:00**. We invite everyone to come, learn more about the larger church and look at this covenant together.
