

## FACILITIES UPDATE SEPTEMBER 2006

Meeting with Structural engineer has been set for Tuesday September 26th at noon here at the church. I, Bill Kriedler and Harvey Frank will be in attendance. If anyone else is interested in attending please let me know. The meeting is scheduled for 2 hours to discuss the safety of our building and what are the immediate and future repairs of the church and parish hall. We then hope to be able to formulate a plan in regards to time and resources.

Carpet will be installed tomorrow in the youth room and the sacristy with new pad and door plates. Total cost \$460.00 approved by Harvey.

I have video tape the entire church and parish hall and surrounding grounds to include all our replaceable assets in case of fire or disaster. I will make 2 copies on CD, one to be kept in the safe, the other off site probably with Harvey.

I am currently collecting bids to have the large cracks in our parking lot filled with asphalt before we incur water damage and a much larger bill to fix the lot. We had the lot repaired and sealed last year with a 2 year warranty from the company. They are no longer in business so we are back to square one. I believe we can make the repairs for around \$600.00 dollars and would like to proceed without further approval.

Ink jet cartridges have been gone through and sent to the company for reimbursement. We are currently looking for a parish member to volunteer to take over this project, but I think until that occurs this might fall under John Mantas vestry position. I have looked over the info and believe this to be a relatively easy way to put some monies in the youth and children's services. We probably want to set this up as a separate account and use it as needed for child/youth related activities. Any feedback?

Fall clean up day will be Saturday October 28th with bad weather day November 4th. Any thing you feel needs to be done on this day please send me and e-mail with your suggestions.
